Welcome to church! If you are a guest today, please stop by the *Welcome Centre*, which is located at the coffee stop in the fellowship foyer. We have an informational booklet and gift we would like you to have. Please do come again!

Today at Calvary - This is Communion Sunday. In Luke 22:19 we read that Jesus took bread and divided it up among his disciples and likewise He did this with the cup. As they were invited to eat and drink, He said, *do this in remembrance of me*. Communion is about remembering that Jesus surrendered His life on the cross that all may be forgiven of sins and have eternal life. During worship we will pause to share in communion together. If you have invited Jesus to be Lord and Savior of your life, you are invited to participate. If you have never made that decision, you can do it right this moment.

Max Lucado said, *When we work, we work; but when we pray, God works*. It is my great desire to see God work in this church and your lives. This morning and next Sunday morning I plan to speak on prayer.
